

PLANT PYRAMID (FOR JACKIE AND AARON)

Use at least seven potted houseplants to create a freestanding pyramid sculpture or triangular wall display.

Add a bright, happy, solid color—minimum 1 yard tall and 1 yard wide—to the pyramid display. If you display the pyramid in front of a wall, paint the wall. If you select a window, install colored, transparent media either on the window glass, or hung as a floating scrim behind the plants. Suggested transparent media are colored vinyl, acetate, or gels.

Throughout the exhibition, care for the plants.

Towards the end of the exhibition, or after its conclusion, give at least three plants as tokens of gratitude to friends, family members, or colleagues. Personalize each plant or pot for each recipient with a handmade decoration. If you give the plant away before the end of the exhibition, photograph the plant with the decorative element and put a color printout in its place for the remainder of the exhibition.

Send me a record of the first name of the recipients; the reason you selected each of them; and any expressions of positive emotion that they share when you present the plant to them.
